## SAINT-AUBIN 1<sup>ER</sup> CRU "Les Combes au Sud"

### THE APPELLATION

*Saint Aubin is situated in the heart of the Côte des Blancs between Chassagne-Montrachet and Puligny-Montrachet; white wines and red wines are produced here but Chardonnay remains predominant. The Saint-Aubin appellation covers a wide area, with an altitude ranging from 300 to 450 metres, and with very varied expositions and soils, which makes each climat unique.*

*The Les Combes au Sud climat adjoins the premiers crus of the Chassagne-Montrachet appellation. This parcel has an eastern aspect.*



#### VARIETY/CLIMAT

100% Chardonnay, in limestone soil.

#### VINIFICATION

The grapes are pressed immediately when they reach the vat room, without prior crushing. Following gentle pressing and light settling, the must is placed directly into barrels.

#### AGEING

Aged for 16 months, of which 12 months in barrels (about 15% new barrels).

#### TASTING

A beautiful golden robe; the nose, a mix of white flowers and flint; on the palate, a nice balance between freshness, tension and smoothness.

#### SERVING GUIDE

12 to 14 degrees.

#### FOOD PAIRING

Enjoy with warm goat's cheese, vol-au-vents, or an oven-baked fish dish.

#### LAYING DOWN

Drink within 5 years.
